- The Dream Center has 14 GRH bedrooms, which are funded through the financial county.
- In addition to the housing, it is where three meals are served each day for all the residents on campus.
- Has the main reception area, staff medication management and business offices are located here.
- Visitation is here, which is open from 8 am to 8 pm. All visitors must have a valid ID and sign papers, prior to visiting with resident.
- Programs are held in the main Café every day from 6 pm to 7 pm.
- Also, all residents must sign in and out here when they leave for the day so that staff is aware of where they are.

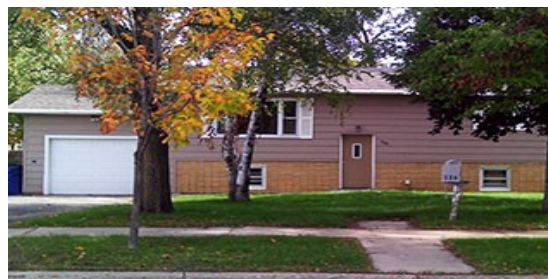
CALEB HOUSE

The Caleb house is located right next to the Dream Center. It has 6 GRH housing beds, offices, and a conference room. Caleb House primarily houses residents with long term, severe and persistent mental illness.



JOSHUA HOUSE

The Joshua House is our newest housing facility. It contains 4 transitional bedrooms, which is a pay to stay setting. It also comes along with a kitchen, living room, laundry room, 2 bathrooms, and a spacious back yard with deck.

HOSPITALITY HOUSE



530 16TH AVENUE NORTH

- This apartment styled housing has 18 rooms.
- 5 bedrooms, located on the top level, are DOC/ISR beds, which are funded through the Department of Corrections.
- The bottom floor has 9 bedrooms, which can help men that have physical mobility issues.
- This housing, also, offers long term care.

RESIDENTIAL HOUSING INFORMATION:

- Housing is available for single men that are actively making changes to their life.
- Referrals are received from a case worker, social worker, PO agent, or other community support.
- Each resident must fill out an Intake form, go through an interview, and sign a Lodging Program contract that is reviewed every 30 days.

What we encourage our men to do while at OIF:

- Attend at least three support groups, either at OIF or outside OIF.
- Set goals each week in the Plan of Actions every Monday.
- Commitment to follow through with all aftercare.
